This page is an example of a budget. It is intended to give you an idea of categories you might include in your budget. Some of these categories may not apply to you; include the ones that are relevant to your request. Be sure to include all expenses that are covered in your application.

Be clear and specific in your budget items; for example, “air travel from Kathmandu to Delhi” or “rent per month in Colombo.”

- List all expenses that are associated with your study or practice.
- The example budget shows many categories, but not all may apply to your study or practice. Include only the categories that are relevant to your proposal.
- All amounts should be in US dollars (\$).
- Preference will be given to applications with a clear budget.
